## GET Cutoors

#### ANGLING

Some of the best fishing spots in upstate are found in Oneida County. Oneida Lake is a bass master's dream and a special destination for walleye and perch. Fly fishing? Cast for brook and brown trout in over 100 miles of public fishing rights on 14 trout creeks and rivers. West Canada Creek is regarded as one of New York's top trout streams. See millions of trout nurtured at Rome Fish Hatchery.

#### CANOEING | KAYAKING | TUBING

Seven lakes and numerous waterways offer on-water experiences from a placid paddle on the historic Erie Canal, tube float down West Canada Creek to Class III whitewater kayaking on Fish Creek.

#### **BIKING | HIKING | WALKING**

Black River Environmental Protection Area (BREIA) Trails offer year-round adventure for mountain biking, hiking, snowshoeing and cross-country skiing. BikeThruHistory.com provides curated

#### **ROSCOE CONKLING PARK**

Roscoe Conkling Park was the first park developed by T.R. Proctor in 1909. Throughout the years the park has added several Utica attractions within its 385 acres, including the Parkway Recreation Center, Val Bialas Ski Area, the New York Energy Zone, a trail system, the Utica Zoo, Valley View Golf Course (designed by Robert Trent Jones), and the South Woods Switchbacks.

The South Woods Switchbacks still retain areas of vegetation much like what early settlers to the region would have seen - ironwood, basswood, viburnum, and other early trees and shrubs! To learn more, visit greenutica.org.

#### CAMPING

With nearly 2,000 campsites, you'll find the picture-perfect spot to pitch a tent, park the RV and relax around the campfire at 19 locally owned campgrounds and two state parks, Delta Lake State Park and Verona Beach State Park.

#### WATCHABLE WILDLIFE

Utica Marsh, a unique urban wetland, accessible from the Erie Canalway Trail, offers up-close views of habitats and a variety of plants and animals, especially birds. An observation tower provides the perfect bird's eye view of the abundant wildlife! Rome Sand Plains is one of only a few inland pine barrens in the nation, teaming with watchable wildlife.

## Winter Activities

#### Embrace winter and bundle up for adventure!

#### **ICE FISHING**

Oneida Lake is the largest lake lying wholly within New York State. With a maximum depth of 55 ft., it freezes during the winter to become a great ice fishing destination for perch and walleye.

#### CROSS-COUNTRY & DOWNHILL SKI

BREIA Trails are a cross-country skier's paradise covering more than 31 miles (50 km), making it one of the largest groomed X-country ski systems in the east. If downhill is more your style, skiers of all ages can hit the slopes - or tube - at Woods Valley Ski Area.

#### CURLING

Utica Curling Club dates back to 1868, and with six sheets of ice, it's the oldest and largest curling club in the eastern US hosting league, open and invitational Bonspiels. Book a Try Curling event and learn to curl!

#### SNOWMOBILING

Oneida County is a premier sledding destination. Home to 12 all-volunteer snowmobile clubs that maintain nearly 600 miles of groomed trails connecting to trail systems in the Tug Hill Plateau and Adirondack Park for endless sledhead fun!

#### **SNOWSHOE**

Head out for a snow hike! Utica Zoo, Black River Environmental Improvement Area (BREIA), Boonville Fire & Rescue and four area public libraries offer snowshoe rentals for a fun and unique winter trek!

#### AN AMERICAN REVOLUTION

"The fort that never surrendered," Fort Stanwix National Monument is best known for successfully thwarting an intense siege in 1777. Fort Stanwix protected traders during the French and Indian War, then played a key role in the Revolutionary War. Oriskany Battlefield is the site of one of the Revolutionary War's most pivotal and deadly battles. Continue on the Revolutionary trail with a visit to the Baron Von Steuben Memorial State Historic Site in Remsen.

#### A WAY OF LIFE

Utica's astounding bygone architecture is preserved at Fountain Elms and the Rutger-Steuben Park National Historic District reflecting the prosperity of Utica before 1900. Discover centuries of Oneida Indian Nation history and heritage at Shako:wi Cultural Center - feel the power of Wampum and marvel



at the craftsmanship involved in creating lacrosse sticks by hand.



#### **ORISKANY BATTLEFIELD**

A significant turning point in the War of Independence, the Battle of Oriskany, fought on August 6, 1777, has been described as one of the bloodiest battles of the war. A monument was dedicated on August 6, 1884, to serve as a memorial to the militia who fought there. Oriskany Battlefield was designated a New York State historic site during the 150th anniversary of the battle in 1927 and was designated a National Historic Landmark in 1963. #### **DID YOU KNOW?**

Utica Club was the first beer sold after Prohibition was repealed. The West End Brewery Company, which would later become the FX Matt Brewery, was the first brewery in the nation to obtain a license on April 7, 1933 and was the first to sell beer. The historic achievement is still noted on bottles and cans of Utica Club - and yes, you can still enjoy this brew today!

#### **STARS AND STRIPES**

Patriotism and the American Flag have special importance here! Rome Cemetery is the final resting place of Francis Julius Bellamy (1855-1931), the original author of the "Pledge of Allegiance". The pledge he wrote was first used October 21, 1892, in honor of the 400th anniversary of the discovery of America.



#### **The Copper City**

Rome is home to **Revere Copper**, hence the nod and notoriety as The Copper City. Featuring two National Parks, Rome's history began as a fortified trading post on one of the most important North American transportation routes, the **Oneida Carry**, commemorated by the **Oneida Indian Nation** with an impressive bronze sculpture in downtown.

Rome's downtown is anchored by Fort Stanwix National Monument. Known as "the fort that never surrendered" for repelling a prolonged siege in 1777. Just six miles away, Oriskany Battlefield State Historic Site serves as an awe-inspiring reminder of one of the Revolutionary War's most deadly engagements. Honor America Days in July is a patriotic celebration with family fun events and an open-air concert on the lawn at Fort Stanwix culminating with a maiestic

fireworks display.

Catch a vintage film at the **Capitol Theatre**, a restored 1928 movie house, host of Capitolfest, CNY's 35mm silent and early talkie film festival. Take a break at **Copper City Brewing Company** to enjoy



local craft beers on tap. Nature lovers will find **Delta Lake State Park**, a great spot for camping, hiking and watersports. Walk or cycle the **Mohawk River Trail**. Spring through fall, **Fort Rickey Discovery Zoo** teaches conservation through engaging animal interactions, kid-friendly attractions and activities.

The Toccolana Club in Rome has 15 groomed Bocce courts and hosts the World Series of Bocce every July. This is the premier bocce tournament in the northeast, where teams from across the country compete for more than \$30,000 in prizes.

the far right side of the shopping plaza on Route 12 in Boonville. In the summer months, the trails are perfect for hiking and mountain biking.

#### **Picturesque Villages & Rural Escapes**

Slow your pace, make the short drive to the Southern Hills region, and find contentment in these aesthetically pleasing New England inspired villages surrounded by rural character.

Founded in 1787 by pioneers from Connecticut, the picturesque Village of Clinton was widely known during the 19th century as "Schooltown" for its many private secondary schools. Hamilton College, founded in 1793 and chartered in 1812, sits atop a hill overlooking the village. Today it stands as one of America's oldest and finest liberal arts colleges.

Root Glen, a trail system open to the public, is a favorite spot for quiet walks among the shaded red-shale paths to admire 65 species of trees, shrubs, plants and flowers. The Ruth and Elmer Wellin Museum includes over 6,000 works of art and artifacts, representing a broad range of cultures, historical periods, and artistic practices and movements.

In 2018 Clinton earned the coveted designation as a Kraft Hockeyville USA community for its more than 100 years of hockey history! Off the ice throughout the year, visitors can stroll a delightful array of locally owned artisan shops, boutiques, restaurants, and cafes. Spring through fall, the Clinton Farmers Market occurs weekly on the village green. Enjoy picturesque rolling hills and relax with a glass of wine at Brimfield Winery.

Since 1903 the Clinton Cider Mill has produced fresh-pressed cider the traditional way. From Labor Day to Thanksgiving, stop in for fresh cider, house-baked donuts, and homemade pie. Clinton sparkles during the holiday season with the 5K Jingle Jog and the Shoppers' Stroll, complete with horse-drawn carriage rides, parade, and a fire pit for s'mores.



The villages of Waterville and Oriskany Falls draw visitors for their graceful settings, pleasing bygone-era architecture, unique eateries and eclectic stores. Oriskany Falls was aptly named for the waterfalls in the center of town, formed by Oriskany Creek. In September, check out Cruisin' Into Waterville, a huge car show featuring classic cars, hot rods and motorcycles, a parade, 5K run/walk, craft fair, BBQ, and a chili cook-off.

#### **DID YOU KNOW?**

Waterville is the birthplace of George Eastman (1854-1932), founder of Eastman Kodak Company. Set your camera to panoramic for a pic of the massive clean energy generating windmills that dot the hilltops and ridges of wind farms throughout the southern hills.
