




MUST-SEE ATTRACTIONS IN ONEIDA COUNTY









Erie Canal Cruises: Lil' Diamond III | Herkimer

Take a ride on the historic Erie Canal aboard the newest ship, the Lil' Diamond III. The ship can hold 120 passengers and is available for dinner cruises. Join the captain on a fun and historically fascinating cruise, back to a time when the canal was just a vision and boats were pulled by mules and horses.

Fort Stanwix National Monument | Rome

Visit the reconstructed fort on the site of the French & Indian War and Revolutionary War military installations. Six Indian treaties were signed at this historic site. Seasonal re-enactments and demonstrations. Take a tour and learn about 18th century life on the western frontier.

F.X. Matt/Saranac Brewery | Utica

Founded in 1888 by German-born immigrant Francis Xavier Matt (F.X.), the Matt Brewing Company is one of the few remaining great American regional breweries. Tours run Monday through Saturday during June, July, and August and Friday and Saturday from September through May. Tours are at 1 and 3 PM. Retail shop and tavern for beer and soda tasting.

Oneida Community Mansion House | Sherrill

This historic home was built brick-by-brick in stages beginning in 1861 by the utopian Oneida Community (1848-1880). The 93,000 square foot Mansion House reflects the community's core belief of personal and social perfection. The decoration mirrors architectural styles of the mid-19th century. Guided tour available. Restaurant on premises.

Irish Cultural Center (ICC) | Utica

A brand new attraction in the heart of the brewery district in Utica. The Irish Cultural Center features Five Points Pub, an authentic Irish restaurant with furnishings straight from Ireland. Also on site is a museum featuring different exhibitions as well as an event center that can host up to 280 people.

Turning Stone Casino Resort | Verona

A renowned, award-winning destination resort nestled in the heart of Central New York, features world-class amenities including four hotels, two luxurious spas, five golf courses, more than 20 dining options, a 125,000 square foot Las Vegas-style gaming floor, a cabaret style Showroom, a 5,000 seat arena, and several nightlife venues.
