MOVIE TRIVIA

Sylvan Beach Union Chapel is a historic interdenominational church located on the waterfront. Worship services have been held on Sundays every summer since 1887. Unique top-hinge doors open wide to reveal views of Oneida Lake. Oscar-nominated film *The Sterile Cuckoo* starring Liza Minnelli was shot in part at the church in 1969. Minnelli's first on-screen kiss was filmed at Union Chapel.

At the Corner of Beach and Canal

Sylvan Beach offers good old-fashioned family fun. Enjoy lazy days of fishing, motorboating, water skiing, swimming and concerts in the park. Two miles of sandy beaches on the eastern shore of Oneida Lake are perfect for sandcastles and sunbathing at Sylvan Beach and Verona Beach State Park. Waterfront cottages and breezy campgrounds provide comfy laid back accommodations for family reunions and getaways. In the winter months, a frozen Oneida Lake becomes a premier ice fishing destination.

Enjoy locally-owned diners like **Eddie's** for a famous hot ham sandwich, **Canalview Cafe**, **Captain John's** and the **Pancake House**. Get your fill of barbeque at **Bone-Yard BBQ** or **Willie's Chop Shop** and choose your favorite New York State craft beer from a 32-tap collection at **Oneida Lake Brew Haus**.

The Lake House at Sylvan Beach features indoor/outdoor dining options, casino gaming and entertainment. It's all about nostalgia at Sylvan Beach Amusement Park with iconic rides like tilt-a-whirl, bumper cars, and amazing views of the lake from atop Galaxi, CNY's largest roller coaster. Since 1896 Carello's Carousel Arcade has been offering classic carousel rides and entertainment. Stay up late for a Park After Dark


Ghost Tour for a possible encounter with spirits that haunt the park!


















A STORIED HISTORY This serene rural part of Oneida County was home to the infamous Loomis family in the 1800's. A time when our nation was wild, unsettled, and fraught with counterfeit money, horse thieves and robbers. Wanted for counterfeiting, petty theft, highway robbery and attempted assassination, the crimes of The Loomis Gang of the Nine Mile Swamp made an indelable mark in history.

Step out of the daily hustle and bustle and get away to the quaint and inviting Southern Hills of Oneida County. Slow your pace, make the short drive, and find contentment in these aesthetically pleasing New England inspired villages surrounded by rural character.

Founded in 1787 by pioneers from Connecticut, the picturesque **Village of Clinton** was widely known during the 19th century for its many private secondary schools, a distinction that earned it the nickname "Schooltown." **Hamilton College**, founded in 1793 sits atop a hill overlooking the village. Chartered as a college in 1812, today it stands as one of America's oldest and finest liberal arts colleges.

The Hamilton campus features **Root Glen**, a trail system open to the public and a favorite spot for quiet walks among the shaded red-shale paths to admire 65 species of trees, shrubs, plants and flowers. Hamilton's **Ruth and Elmer Wellin Museum** includes over 6,000 works of art and artifacts, representing a broad range of cultures, historical periods, and artistic practices and movements.


The Village of Clinton has more than 100 years of hockey history. In 2018 Clinton earned the coveted designation as a **Kraft Hockeyville USA** community! Off the ice and throughout the year, visitors can stroll a delightful array of locally-owned artisan shops, specialty boutiques, restaurants and cafes. Spring

through fall, be sure to visit the Clinton Farmers Market on the village green. Enjoy a picturesque view of scenic rolling hills and relax with a glass of wine at Brimfield Winery.


Since 1903 the Clinton Cider Mill has produced fresh-pressed cider the traditional way. From Labor Day through Thanksgiving, stop in for fresh cider, house-baked donuts and homemade pie. Clinton sparkles during the Christmas holiday season with the 5K Jingle Jog and the Clinton Shoppers' Stroll, complete with horse-drawn carriage rides, holiday parade, and a fire pit for s'mores.

The villages of Waterville and Oriskany Falls draw visitors for their graceful settings, pleasing bygone-era architecture, unique eateries and eclectic stores. Oriskany Falls was aptly named for the waterfalls in the center of town, formed by Oriskany Creek. In September, check out Cruisin' Into Waterville, a huge car show featuring classic cars, hot rods and motorcycles, a parade, 5K run/walk, craft fair, BBQ, and a chili cook-off.

Waterville is the birthplace of George Eastman (1854-1932), founder of Eastman Kodak Company. Set your camera to panoramic for a pic of the massive clean energy generating windmills that dot the hilltops and ridges of wind farms throughout the southern hills.

Check out our **A to Z Food Tour** on Instagram for a wide variety of dishes with international flair, celebrated local favorites, farm-to-table, and chef inspired creations! Be sure to try these original dishes unique to the area:

HALF-MOONS | Made famous by **Hemstrought's Bakeries** in 1920, half-moons are the perfect mix of smooth chocolate fudge and buttercream frosting atop a soft 'cake-like' cookie.

CHICKEN RIGGIES | An Italian-American pasta dish native to Utica-Rome. Many variations exist at local restaurants. The dish typically consists of chicken, rigatoni, and hot or sweet peppers in a spicy cream and tomato sauce.

UTICA GREENS | An Upstate NY icon since the 1980s, this Italian-American dish is made of sauteed greens, escarole or chicory, garlic, hot peppers, parmesan cheese, pecorino, prosciutto and bread crumbs.

TOMATO PIE | Dating back to 1910 at **O'Scugnizzo's Pizzeria** in Utica, this Italian-American thick crust, focaccia-like dough, is covered with tomato sauce, topped with romano cheese and served at room temperature.

TURKEY JOINTS | A unique candy confection created by **Nora's Candy Shop in Rome**. The original recipe is a blend of chocolate and hazelnuts or Brazil nuts covered with a sweet silvery coating.



GNY FRESH Adventures in Agriculture



neida County delivers fresh destinations with endless selections of fresh produce, meats, dairy, baked goods and agritourism attractions. Treat the family to healthy fresh fruits and veggies from **Oneida County Public Market** at Union Station on Saturday mornings or from eight different farmers markets six days a week.

AGRI-FEST

The sap flows in March and is the star attraction of NYS Maple Weekends. Connect with a master gardener at Herb & Flower Fest, stroll greenhouses of blooms and fields of lavender. On the first Friday in June, Farm Fest offers a day of interactive learning at a local dairy farm. The Boonville-Oneida County Fair features the best in agriculture while NYS Woodsmen's Field Days brings professional lumberjack and lumberjill competition to the fairgrounds in August.

BARN QUILT TRAIL

Take a self-driving tour through the lush scenic farmlands of Oneida County to discover a rich history of agriculture and family traditions. Eight foot by eight foot colorful quilt block patterns adorn numerous barns and outbuildings throughout Oneida County's farm community. Visit oneidacountytourism. com/barn-quilt-trail.

















Ide open spaces abound providing ample room and opportunity to escape the hustle and bustle for a camping getaway, connect with nature or meet the personal challenge of a big catch, ride, paddle or hike.

CANOEING | KAYAKING | TUBING

Seven lakes and numerous waterways offer on-water experiences from a placid paddle on the historic **Erie Cana**l, tube float down **West Canada Creek** to Class III whitewater kayaking on **Fish Creek**.

BIKING | HIKING | WALKING

Black River Environmental Protection Area (BREIA) Trails offer year-round adventure for mountain biking, hiking, snowshoeing and cross-country skiing. BikeThruHistory.com provides curated rides to history sites in the region. Pixley Falls State Park's main attraction is a 50-foot waterfall. This picturesque park features a picnic area, wooded hills and a mountain stream. Find more waterfall hikes in the Tug Hill Region at visittughill.com/waterfalls.

CAMPING

With nearly 2,000 campsites, you'll find the picture-perfect spot to pitch a tent, park the RV and relax around the campfire at 19 locally owned campgrounds and two State Parks, Delta Lake State Park and Verona Beach State Park.

WATCHABLE WILDLIFE

Utica Marsh, a unique urban wetland, accessible from the Erie Canalway Trail, offers up-close views of habitats and a variety of plants and animals, especially birds. An observation tower provides the perfect bird's eye view of the abundant wildlife! Rome Sand Plains is one of only a few inland pine barrens in the nation, teaming with watchable wildlife.

GEMS FROM EARTH

Herkimer Diamond Mines delivers a unique adventure for all ages. Go prospecting in above ground surface mines for dazzling Quartz Crystals! Crack open geodes in search of beautiful crystals formed over 500 million years ago. Keep everything you find and create your own stunning jewelry!



HOCKEY

AHL pro hockey team **Utica Comets**, affiliated with NHL's New Jersey Devils, and **Utica University Pioneers** play on home ice at the **Adirondack Bank Center Utica Memorial Auditorium** to thousands of cheering hockey fans each season.

ICE FISHING

Oneida Lake is the largest lake lying wholly within New York State. With a maximum depth of 55 feet, it freezes during the winter to become a great ice fishing destination for perch and walleye.

CROSS-COUNTRY & DOWNHILL SKI

BREIA Trails are a cross-country skier's paradise covering more than 31 miles (50km), making it one of the largest groomed X-country ski systems in the east. If downhill is more your style, skiers of all ages can hit the slopes - or tube - at **Woods Valley Ski Area**.

CURLING

Utica Curling Club dates back to 1868, and with six sheets of ice, it's the oldest and largest curling club in the eastern US hosting league, open and invitational Bonspiels. Book a Try Curling event and learn to curl!

SNOWMOBILING

Oneida County is a premier sledding destination. Home to 12 all-volunteer snowmobile clubs that maintain nearly 600 miles of groomed trails connecting to trail systems in the **Tug Hill Plateau** and **Adirondack Park** for endless sledhead fun!

SNOWSHOE

Head out for a snow hike! Utica Zoo, Black River Environmental Improvement Area (BREIA), Boonville Fire & Rescue and four area public libraries offer snowshoe rentals for a fun and unique winter trek!

ur communities deliver a getaway with international flair. From sculpture gardens, world-renowned galleries and local exhibitions to Broadway performances, community theatre and vintage film festivals you'll find inspiring events and experiences year round.

ON VIEW

Munson-Williams-Proctor Museum of Art has works on view by some of history's most celebrated visionaries like Picasso and Pollock, plus Thomas Cole's original "Voyage of Life" series, all showcased in a Philip Johnson designed building listed on the Register of Historic Places. **Wellin Museum of Art** collections represent a diverse array of periods and media like Greek and Roman antiquities, Native American art, Chinese ritual bronzes and pieces from pre-Columbian Mesoamerica.

Artists-in-residence explore new frontiers at **Sculpture Space**. Stroll through their commissioned public art installations at **Griffiss International Sculpture Garden**. View a thoughtful selection of outstanding performances and regional exhibits at **Kirkland Art Center** and **Rome Art and Community Center**.

ON STAGE

The Stanley, Utica's opulent 1928 theatre features Mexican Baroque architecture, plays host to a full series of **Broadway** shows fall to spring. **Theatre at Woodshill** conducts a summertime Shakespeare festival in an iconic round-roof barn on a picturesque farm setting. **Players of Utica**, **Rome Community Theater** and **Unity Hall** offer intimate performance settings. **Capitol Theatre**, Rome's historic 1928 movie palace, attracts vintage film buffs from around the world each year for **Capitolfest**, a 3-day rare 35mm silent and early talkie movie film festival.







-DID YOU KNOW?-

Every July Genesee Street comes alive with sights and sounds of the Munson-Williams-Proctor Arts Festival. The Sidewalk Art Show began in 1939, making it one of the area's longest-running art exhibitions. Utica's Levitt Amp Music Series rocks 10 weeks of free, family-friendly outdoor concerts at Kopernik Park in Oneida Square with national head-liners, regional/local opening acts and the most diverse audience in the area.





DO YOU BELIEVE?

Whether you're a true believer in ghosts or a die-hard skeptic, the spooky sites on the **Haunted History Trail of New York State** will test your beliefs. Locally, stay up late for a **Park After Dark Tours** at Sylvan Beach Amusement Park or a guided **Rome Lamplighter Tour.** Visit HauntedHistoryTrail.com for more haunts!

ocated at the convergence of many important trade and travel routes, an extraordinarily diverse amount of significant history happened here. Explore engaging exhibits and artifacts to connect with our passion for the past.

AN AMERICAN REVOLUTION

"The fort that never surrendered," Fort Stanwix National Monument is best known for successfully thwarting an intense siege in 1777. Fort Stanwix protected traders during the French and Indian War, then played a key role in the Revolutionary War. Oriskany Battlefield is the site of one of the Revolutionary War's most pivotal and deadly battles. Continue on the Revolutionary trail with a visit to the Baron Von Steuben Memorial State Historic Site in Remsen.

ENGINEERING AND INGENUITY

The **Erie Canal** was heralded as an engineering marvel. The first dig began in Rome July 4, 1817, and spurred the expansion

of America. Enjoy a relaxing cruise aboard Erie Canal Cruises for a historic narration of this iconic national landmark. Oneida Community Mansion House offers an intriguing tour into a mysterious utopian community that endured for decades, best known for its craftsmanship of Oneida Silver. For a vintage selfie backdrop, visit the perfectly preserved H.P. Sears Oil Company Service Station Museum in Rome.

A WAY OF LIFE

Utica's astounding bygone architecture is preserved at Fountain Elms and the Rutger-Steuben Park National Historic District reflecting the prosperity of Utica before 1900. Discover Oneida Indian Nation history and heritage at Shako:wi Cultural Center - feel the power of wampum and marvel at the craftsmanship involved in creating lacrosse sticks by hand.

DID YOU KNOW? -

Utica is the childhood home of **Saint Marianne Cope** (1838-1918), canonized by the Vatican in 2012 for her extraordinary acts of selflessness in providing healthcare to a city of immigrants ensuring all were welcomed and provided the same quality of care regardless of race, ethnicity, religion, or economic means. Visit her home parish St. Joseph's & St. Patrick's on Columbia Street and her **Home Garden Shrine** on Schuyler Street.

RUNS. WALKS & RIDES

Boilermaker Road Race is undoubtedly Central New York's crown jewel 15K endurance racing event. 19,000 runners, massive crowds, live music, and a post-race party you don't want to miss, make it a memorable race like no other. Follow the path of history, run the Erie Canal Half Marathon or cycle the Tour the Towpath ride along the Erie Canal. Thousands of cyclists enjoy the challenge of the 100-mile Ride for Missing Children and the 400-mile Cycle the Erie Bike Tour each year.

PROFESSIONAL FOOTBALL CLUB

PLAY BALL

The boys of summer, **Utica Blue Sox** and **Adirondack Trail Blazers**, take to the field as part of the Perfect Game Collegiate League. 
