

Erie Canal Cruises: Lil' Diamond II | Herkimer

We invite you to join us on our USGC Certified vessel for a fun and historically fascinating cruise, back to a time when the canal was just a vision and the barges were pulled by mules and horses. Travel through a hundred-year-old lock, relax and enjoy – you'll be glad you did.

Fort Stanwix National Monument | Rome

Visit the reconstructed fort on the site of the French & Indian War and Revolutionary War military installations. Six Indian treaties were signed at this historic site. Seasonal re-enactments and demonstrations. Take a tour and learn about 18th century life on the western frontier.

F.X. Matt/Saranac Brewery | Utica

Founded in 1888 by German-born immigrant Francis Xavier Matt (F.X.), the Matt Brewing Company is one of the few remaining great American regional breweries. Tours of the brewery are available by appointment.

Irish Cultural Center (ICC) | Utica

An attraction in the heart of the brewery district in Utica. The Irish Cultural Center features Five Points Pub, an authentic Irish restaurant with furnishings straight from Ireland. Also on site is a museum featuring different exhibitions as well as an event center that can host up to 280 people.

Munson Williams Proctor Arts Institute | Utica

With more than 13,500 pieces in its permanent collection, concerts, community classes and a college of art and design, Munson-Williams-Proctor Arts Institute is the cultural heart of Central New York. The Museum of Art presents 15 exhibitions

annually, drawing from the permanent collection and traveling exhibitions from other leading institutions. These are featured in a 1960 Museum building designed by Philip Johnson and in Fountain Elms, the 1858 ancestral home of the Institutes founders.

Prospect Falls Winery | Prospect

Open for business Wednesday-Sunday offering behind-the-scenes tours of the winery as well as wine-making classes. Tasting room for wine and locally crafted items.

The Stanley Theatre | Utica

The design motif of the Stanley Theatre is dubbed "Mexican Baroque" because of its unique blend of styles. Shows occur throughout the year and private events and tours can be arranged.

Turning Stone Casino Resort | Verona

A renowned, award-winning destination resort nestled in the heart of Central New York, features world-class amenities including 5 hotels, two luxurious spas, five golf courses, more than 20 dining options, a 125,000 square foot Las Vegas-style gaming floor, a cabaret style Showroom, a 5,000 seat arena, and several nightlife venues.
